

The Row at Weeting, situated in the centre of the village, was built in the mid 18th century and is reputed to be the longest row of thatched listed cottages in England.

When chimney fires damaged the structure, CCL was called in to carry out emergency structural safety inspections and we arranged temporary structural safety inspections and we arranged temporary works to make them safe. We then worked as the Contract Administrator for the duration of the contract to refurbish the cottages, producing drawings and detailed specifications to sympathetically rebuild the cottages in conjunction with statutory requirements.
